Project duration: 2 years

This project aims to **strengthen the goat sector's value chain**, starting from goat farming to the production of value added products, whilst **empowering women** by fostering job opportunities in the sector.

The targeted region is affected by **high poverty levels**, with 60% of the population living below the poverty line and a **growing food insecurity** under the impact of climate change in the Horn of Africa. More than ever, it is necessary to strengthen the goat farming sector's resilience by introducing **innovative**, **sustainable and profitable production and farming techniques**.


