
Boosting agricultural production by creating service centers for 350.000 smallholde





## Burkina Faso – East, Central-North, North and Plateau-Central regions

Project duration: 5 years (2019-2023)



This project aims to create agricultural service centers to support smallholder farmers in four vulnerable regions of the Great Green Wall. This initiative is part of a vast land restoration program launched by SOS SAHEL in 2019 in Burkina Faso where 34% of the land is marked by large-scale degradation. Since its implementation, 15.000 ha of degraded land have been restored and have helped stimulate agricultural production. Smallholder farmers are now in need of nearby service centers to improve their agricultural yields and commercial capacities, which will secure their income and food security.




